### Miscellaneous EMV PDL Updates

**Effective February 4, 2020** Heartland has rescheduled a previously announced update that will make multiple configuration changes to the EMV Parameter Download system tables. POS systems connected to the Heartland EMV PDL system will receive the updates automatically.

In addition to the changes announced previously in PMB 1143 to remove CVM (cardholder verification method) filtering by AID (application ID number), this change will now also include removing CVM filtering that affected TAC (terminal action code) values transmitted during an EMV PDL update. These changes will allow all certified CVMs particular to each device to be available on all AIDs and not restrict the transmission of TAC values based on CVM capability. These changes will replicate a change made to the certification region EMV PDL system in October 2019.
