Revised Visa Sunset Dates for Expired PIN Entry Devices

Effective immediately, the Visa PIN Security Program Guide has been updated to revise the sunset dates for a variety of expired PIN Entry Devices (PEDs) and Point of Sale (POS) systems. A rigid architecture that does not support revised security codes, malware patching, or terminal management systems used to distribute updates and patches could put the expired device at risk for an attack due to exposure vulnerability. Ensuring the security of the POS devices a cardholder uses to enter their PIN is essential to cardholder PIN protection.

Updated effective dates are as follows:
