NWS Updates for AFD Pump Limits

In response to the recent card brand Automated Fuel Dispenser limit increases, Heartland's NWS platform will make the following changes during the week of May 23rd:

Visa

The existing default pump shut off limit of \$125 for chip based transactions will be increased to **\$175** for non-fleet transactions. There are no changes for fleet transactions.

NOTE: In a future release, the basis for the higher limit will be changed from the presence of chip data to the chip capability of the terminal. Heartland will communicate when the logic change will occur.

Mastercard

No changes will be made at this time due to the fraud liability that would be present on foreign issued cards if the default limit were increased. Heartland will address this change in October when the limit will apply to all cards.

Discover

The existing default pump shut off limit of \$100 will be increased to **\$175**.
