### Visa Update for Fleet 2.0 Requirement

Visa has announced that merchants in specific categories must support Visa Fleet 2.0 processing by **October 2023**. The merchant category codes (MCCs) that must support this special processing are:

- MCC 4468—Marinas, Marine Service, and Supplies
- MCC 5499—Miscellaneous Food Stores—Convenience Stores and Specialty Markets
- MCC 5541—Service Stations (With or without Ancillary Services)
- MCC 5542—Automated Fuel Dispensers
- MCC 5983—Fuel Dealers—Fuel Oil, Wood, Coal, and Liquefied Petroleum

Visa Fleet 2.0 processing leverages capabilities found in EMV chips to expand the on-line data that is transmitted from the merchant to the issuer. The new product also supports data that can be stored and read from the card's chip and adds new messages that can be sent and received by the merchant.

Heartland is currently certifying its NWS and VAPS host to meet the new requirements and plans to install our code changes in October 2022. After those changes, revised POS specifications will be published.
